

Top Golf – Rodeo Goat – Martin House

Saturday, November 10, 2018

We will start by meeting at 9:00 am at [Top Golf](#) in Fort Worth, 2201 E 4th St., just northeast of downtown (between 35 and the West Fork of the Trinity River). Each person will have to purchase a players card for \$5.00 (if you already have one, then bring it along!) and each bay rental is \$25.00 per hour. We can decide how many people will be playing in each bay when we meet and see how many people there are total. Each bay can hold up to six players with 2 additional spectators (non-players) for a total of 8 people. The plan is to play for 2 hours so everyone gets plenty of play time! We will divide the bay rental fee between the players in each lane. With 6 people playing you can expect to pay \$8.40 for your lane rental up to \$12.50 if 4 players are in a bay. You do not need to bring your own clubs, there are clubs in each bay to use for free, but if you have a set you want to play with, bring them along! Food and drinks are available for purchase.

We will then head about 4 miles west to [Rodeo Goat](#), 2836 Bledsoe at Currie. This is a great burger restaurant just off 7th Street. They have quite a selection of burgers, from the Nanny Goat (herb goat cheese, bibb lettuce, beefsteak tomato, onion, and garlic-herb mayo) to the Hot Bastard (habanero cheddar, marinated fresno peppers, bibb lettuce, beefsteak tomato, onion, and fresno aioli). Their current burger battle is between the Big Tex and the Truffle Shuffle, you can vote by purchasing one of the current burger battle burgers.

If you are still up for more friends and fun, we will be driving back just across the river from Top Golf to [Martin House Brewing Company](#), 220 S Sylvania Ave #209. Here you can visit the taproom and see what is brewing. Wristbands can be purchased for \$10 and you will get four 8 ounce pours and a pint glass. You can also purchase beer by the glass or flight. Their tap list contains more than 25 beers ranging from Year Round Brews like Salty Lady and Imperial Texan, MicroSeasonals like Peanut Butter Pretzel Stout and Tres Leches Cinnamon, to Taproom Specials called Hold On To Your Butts, Occam's Razor, and Mamma's Fruit Salad. There is plenty of seating in the brewery, but I suggest you bring your own chair and we can gather in the backyard park along the Trinity River. It looks like it will be a cool day, so bring a sweater or a blanket to keep warm! Even though we will have just devoured some wonderful burgers, if you want to bring some munchies to have with your beer feel free to pack the snacks! The brewery does sell non-alcoholic beverages (sodas and water) and there should be a food truck on the premises if you are in need of more food before driving home! You can stay at the brewery as long as you would like. Martin House will be tapping their brew-of-the-week, For Those About To Rock, at 4pm.

If you do not want to golf but want to do lunch, the plan is to be at Rodeo Goat around 11:30 – 12:00. I will post on the Facebook page when we are leaving Top Golf and heading to the restaurant.

From Top Golf to Rodeo Goat:

Right out of Top Golf onto 4th St.

Under train tracks 4th turns into 3rd St.

Right on Grove St when 3rd turns into a 1 way street.

Left on Belknap. Stay in the left two lanes to stay on Belknap (not Forrest Park)

Right on 7th St.

Left on Foch St (at the light)

Right on Bledsoe St. (This is now a one way street)

Rodeo Goat will be on your right.

To reverse the route to get to Martin House you will need to go north on Currie and right on 7th Street. After crossing into downtown you will need to go right on Weatherford (1 way) not Belknap.
